



**CLUB UPDATE:**  
**CLUB REOPENING ON 24 MARCH 2020, 11AM.**

Dear Members,

We thank you for your patience and understanding during the Club's closure this past weekend, during which the following was done:

- A professional company registered with and approved by the National Environmental Agency (NEA) was engaged to clean and disinfect all three levels of the Clubhouse; this has now been completed.
- The contact tracing exercise has been completed by the Ministry of Health (MOH) and all those who have come into contact with the member in question have been contacted; MOH officers are now following up with all concerned and all necessary steps and precautions have been taken by MOH.

The health and safety of our Members and staff remain our foremost priority and as such, we will ensure our operations adhere to the latest MOH advisories while we will also put in place additional tighter measures.

Please note that **until further notice, the Clubhouse will now open at 11am daily**, and the following operational changes will be implemented:

1. Dedicated area outside the Clubhouse for temperature screening
2. Revised operating hours to allow for more frequent cleaning of F&B outlets
3. Rearrangement of seating in F&B outlets for social distancing
4. Suspension of social events and banquet catering events
5. Stricter guidelines for sports activities
6. Split-team work arrangements

**DEDICATED TENT SET-UP FOR TEMPERATURE SCREENING**

The Visitor Registration procedure will now take place in a Screening Tent located at the carpark adjacent to St. Andrew's Road.

1. Filling out of the SCC Health & Travel Declaration Form:
  - Members and guests must fill out the form when they visit the Club; should they be visiting multiple times in a day, they can fill the form out once but must keep the form-receipt email as proof of submission.
2. Compulsory Temperature Screening:
  - Only persons with temperature below 37.5°C will be allowed into the Clubhouse.
  - If your temperature is 37.5°C and above, you will be moved to a designated location to wait for 5 minutes for another temperature check. If your temperature remains unchanged, we will unfortunately have to turn you away to seek medical attention.

All Members and guests will have to undergo the screening procedure before they can enter the Clubhouse; those who do not do so will be denied entry into the Club. Members will still have to sign in their guests after they enter the Clubhouse at MSD.

Members and/or guests serving Stay-Home Notices (SHN), Leave of Absence (LOA) or Quarantine Orders (QO) must abide by them and not visit the Club. If you have been in contact with anyone on SHN, LOA and/or QO, you will not be allowed to visit the Club for 14 days from the date that contact was made. If you are feeling unwell, even with mild flu-like symptoms, please see a doctor, stay at home, and not visit the Club.

Additionally, cleaning of front-of-house, back-of-house and kitchens will continue to be conducted more frequently using recommended cleaning disinfectants.
