LIGHTING RENDERING (EXTERIOR NIGHT TIME)



The lighting within the canopy area comprises of two components. The first component is an uplighting to the roof underside while the second is a downlighting to the seating area. The uplights are mounted on the columns above the arches. These serve to provide a gentle illumination to the underside of the ETFE roof creating a soft ambient glow which can be viewed from the Padang. The downlights are mounted on the horizontal roof beam structure. These serve a more functional purpose of illuminating the semi-outdoor dining space. These downlights have been carefully positioned away from the ceiling fans to avoid creating flickering shadows to maintain a pleasant dining experience.
