Terms and Conditions

- All ticket prices are inclusive of GST, freeflow food and 1 welcome drink each day. Subsequent beverages are chargeable.
- Tickets will be charged to member's monthly statement and to be paid by the due date of the statement or 23 August 2026 (whichever is earlier). For tickets purchased after 23 August 2026, immediate payment will be required through PayNow or Bank Transfer.
- Please note that bookings may only be made through the official booking form – <https://bit.ly/sccnightrace2026>
- Tickets are free roaming/seating with the exception of the hospitality suites at the Club.
- Each SCC Night Race ticket is inclusive of an official SGP Zone 4 walkabout ticket and an entrance ticket to SCC.
- Please note that both tickets are compulsory for entry to both the SGP circuit and SCC.
- All guests must be signed in by an active SCC Member upon entry to the event.
- Each principal Member (this excludes family/spouse memberships) can only each purchase four Guest tickets across all ticket categories. Individuals aged 16 and above will be considered as guest tickets unless they are registered as a family member under a SCC membership.

SCC Night Race 2026 - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1) What are the operational hours of the Club during the SCC Night Race 2026 for ticket-holders?

The operational hours are 3:00pm – 12:00 midnight daily for 9 – 11 October 2026.

2) What is included in the ticket price?

All ticket prices include entry to the SCC Clubhouse and lunch, dinner and supper buffets, one (1) welcome drink per ticket limited to house pour wines, beer and soft drinks (subsequent beverages are chargeable); it also includes Singapore Grand Prix Zone 4 walkabout access (including the Main Padang concert area).

Ticket prices are inclusive of GST.

3) How many guest tickets can I purchase?

Each Principal Member (family membership is considered part of the principal membership, and is not separate) may purchase up to four (4) guest tickets.

For example, if your spouse is registered as a Family Member and wants to attend, you are limited to purchasing a total of two (2) member tickets (for you and your spouse) and a total of four (4) guest tickets as per your membership allocation.

4) Can the tickets be delivered to members?

Yes, tickets can be delivered by courier for an additional fee of SGD 30 per location.

5) What is the dress code?

Men: Long pants, bermudas or jeans, T-shirts with sleeves, caps and covered shoes.

Ladies: Smart casual attire and caps.

Slippers, flip-flops and clogs are not permitted.

6) Is there any other way to purchase tickets besides the online SCC site?

No. All tickets must be purchased online via the authorised SCC channel only, as we require a timestamp of purchase.

7) What happens if I lose my ticket?

There are no replacements for lost tickets. Members who have misplaced their tickets will need to re-purchase a new ticket in order to attend the SCC Night Race.

Kindly inform the SCC Night Race team if you have lost your ticket and intend to make a re-purchase, so that we can check on ticket availability. Should there still be tickets available, then you will be allocated replacement tickets for your purchasing.

8) Can I buy tickets for my guests without attending the event myself?

Yes. However, you must provide the name of another Member who will be attending the event to the SCC Night Race team; said Member will have to sign the guest in during the event.

9) If a Member is unwell, can their guest attend on their own?

No. All guests must be signed in by a Member of the Club. If you are unable to attend, you may provide the name of another attending Member to sign your guest in.
