PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

Our Sports Sections have been very busy these past months. The SCC Squash Team 1 won the Premier category in the National Squash League in early July. Meanwhile, the SCC Men's Hockey League 1 (MHL 1) and Women's Hockey League (WHL 1) teams clinched third place in the National Hockey League. The Rugby Section Men's team was the overall Champion in the SRU Club 7s tournament, and the Rugby U20 Team also emerged Champion in U20 Club 7s 2023.

The SCC Bowls Ladies team won the National Triples Championship 2023, while the Men's team was the second runner-up in the tournament. Glenn Yeo won the National Billiards Championship 2023. Later in August, SCC Bowls also won the Inter-Club competition. Five of our Bowlers have been chosen to represent Singapore at the World Bowls Championship happening 29 August – 10 September, while two others will be there as officials. Philomena Goh will also be representing Singapore in the Champion of Champions tournament in mid-September, having emerged as the Champion for National Singles 2023.

SCC's Shaheed Alam won the Pesta Sukan Tennis Open in a 128-player draw. The SCC Ospreys came in third in Division 7A in the MiRXES National Netball League 2023; SCC Netball was also the second runner-up at the Deloitte Pesta Sukan. Our SCC Football O50 squad won I the 2023 FAS Singapore Masters Tournament.

Well done to our sportspersons for their dedication to their sport and hard work training – thank you for flying the SCC flag so high!

There has been a flurry of activity on the Padang field with the dismantling of the National Day Parade infrastructure and set-up for the Singapore Formula One Grand Prix. At the Club, our management and staff are working hard to get everything ready for the SCC Night Race happening 15 – 17 September 2023; tickets sold out rapidly, and we know members and guests are raring to go for a fun weekend of exciting racing action, excellent hospitality and entertainment.

Also coming up is the SCC International Rugby7s Tournament which will return 3 – 5 November 2023 to the Padang. A total

of 14 teams have been confirmed, including teams from New Zealand, Fiji, Australia, Japan, Malaysia and Singapore. Bookings for corporate hospitality packages are available, as well as branding opportunities – there are limited slots for corporate hospitality, so do book them early by emailing scc7s@scc.org.sg.

To maintain the distinguished look and feel of our conservation Clubhouse, we will now be keeping the spaces of Gilmour Terrace and Stumps Terrace open and airy without tentage. For key Club events, temporary shelter will be erected and removed immediately afterwards.

We thank the membership for participating in the recent call for feedback about the Men's Bar, improvements and branding. The F&B Subcommittee is currently working through all your submissions and discussing strategies for the short-, mid- and long-term, which will be considered by the General Committee.

The Club will be holding a Special General Meeting (SGM) on 25 September 2023 to discuss and vote on a number of pertinent issues, including the lease renewal; voting members will have received correspondence about this very soon. It is important that members are involved in determining the direction the Club takes and participating in key decisions. We look forward to the participation of our voting members on the day.

For the convenience of member's guests and reciprocal club members, we will be making credit card payments available at the Club from mid-September, to replace the current red debit card. Please look for more information in our Club eBlasts and the Member Services Desk in the coming weeks.

SCC NIGHT RACE TICKET HOLDERS

- As the Singapore Cricket Club is located within the circuit park, access to the Club will only be permitted for SCC Night Race ticket holders from Friday, 15 September to Sunday, 17 September.
- The Club may be accessed via Gate 4. Members may download the circuit map from the SGP website for details and reference.
- Pedestrian access will be available on 15 September to 17 September via Gate 4 located near the Asian Civilisations
 Museum.

GENERAL ROAD CLOSURE

- St Andrews Road / Parliament Place There will be no vehicular access into the Club from Wednesday, 13 September 0000hrs to Tuesday, 19 September 0530hrs.
- Members who plan to drive are advised to exit the Clubhouse on Tuesday, 12 September, by 2300hrs before the road closure commences.

SCC New Master Wine List


With the addition of 30 labels, the new SCC Master Wine Lists boasts 118 wines of red, white, sparkling, rosé and dessert varieties.





SCC NATURE TRAIL WALK

Saturday, 29 July 2023

19 SCC members gathered at 7.30 am at Sentosa Beach Station where GC Member Jon Robinson kicked off the walk by giving the group a brief overview of the trails that they would be embarking on.

The first trail was the Imbiah trail along which there was a lot of flora and fauna. Members also walked the Mount Imbiah Battery route where defence posts were built in the 1880s as part of Singapore's coastal defense. The Imbiah and Siloso batteries were designed to protect the western entrance of the harbour, with Mount Imbiah serving as the command post. Mount Imbiah Battery ceased all operations in the 1930s when a new one was built on the southern end of mainland Singapore at Fort Connaught. The gun was dismantled, and the fort was abandoned, leaving behind a shell which the members explored, with some sharing their knowledge of the history and significance of the command post.

The final route was the Coastal trail walk which encompasses Sentosa's coastal forest and functions as a haven for many local wildlife, including bats, birds, macaques, snakes and squirrels. This coastal forest is also home to many endangered species of plants such as the Seashore Mangosteen and Dracena Minyagi which, at 200 years old, is the oldest tree species on the island. At the end of the walk, members took photos at the canons in front of Fort Siloso.




